Minutes of the Roosevelt Arts, Parks and Recreation Committee

May 6, 2020

Conducted via Zoom

The meeting was called to order at 7 p.m. by Wendy Nicholson, Chairperson

Roll Call: Wendy Nicholson, Amy Snow, Royce Porter, Phillip Bertoch, Shannon Staker, Emily Graham, JR Bird, Mark Winterton, Rowdy Cloward, Brent Fenn, Preston Kadleck, Jeramie Tubbs, Kaycee Anderson, Connie Elison, Daniel Mauchley, Steven Winterton, Don Busenbark, Cade Kowallis

Minutes: Emily Graham made a motion to accept the 3/4/2020 minutes. Preston Kadleck seconded the motion. The voting was unanimous in favor of accepting the minutes.

Public Comment: The public was asked to respond via Facebook. There were not responses.

Business:

July 4th: Mark Winterton said he had Charley Jenkins lined up to perform, the sound is set. It will be set up by 9 am so it can be used for the Red Mud Run. Mark proposed disregarding TriCounty health's health guidelines and moving forward with plans for the event. JR Bird suggested we poll the community and see if they are willing to come to the events. There will be a conference call 5/7/20 with Tri County Health, JR Bird, Mark Winterton and Subcommittee chairs. Shannon Staker suggested that we should be good citizens and following the guidelines set forth by the governor. She said it could be risky for the city to hold events on the 4th. JR Bird said legally we cannot plan to hold events on July 4th. JR Bird also said he was pushing to get our area moved down to a yellow risk level. Connie Elison asked if the events could be scaled back, if possibly just fireworks could be done. Wendy Nicholson is not in favor of a community poll, feels it should not be decided by popular vote. Phillip Bertoch made a motion to table the discussion until a later date. Connie Elison 2nd the motion. The voting was unanimous in favor of tabling the discussion.

Master Events Calendar: Connie Elison made a motion to table the discussion of a master events calendar until later. Emily Graham seconded the motion. The voting was in favor of tabling the discussion.

Itty Bitty Roosevelt: A citywide photo scavenger hunt that could be done in small groups and at any time. The Art Subcommittee will head up this activity. Chairperson Nicholson encouraged all subcommittees to come up with events that could be done while still practicing social distancing. A bird scavenger hunt was suggested as a possibility.

Reports from Committees:

Recreation: The bird festival planned for May had to be cancelled. Disc golf is moving forward. TriCounty Health has committed to sponsoring a hole. The holes could possibly be ready by July 4th. The committee is looking into a possible trail near Gusher. There will be a workout circuit included with the construction of the new baseball diamonds.

Arts: A discussion was had about Missoula Children's theater. We have the option to postpone or cancel and get our money back. Mindy Palmer from Union High is willing to run a children's drama camp during the summer. It would last two weeks and she would use high school students to help her. She will use it

as a fund raiser for the high school drama department. Phillip Bertoch, however, said the high school building could not be made available for the camp this summer. A motion to cancel Missoula Children's theater by Connie Elison with a second by Emily Graham. The voting was in favor of cancelling.

Parks: Co-ed volleyball was cancelled after only one night. The money will be refunded. It is not possible to play team sports at this time per health recommendations from the states. This will be reevaluated May 15. All other spring sports have been cancelled or postponed.

Report from City Council: Don Busenbark had nothing to report. JR Bird stated that the committee is doing a great job.

Wendy Nicholson made a motion to adjourn. Emily Graham seconded the motion. The voting was all in favor of adjourning.
