Reports from Committees:

Recreation: Three Disc Golf baskets were installed in Constitution Park. Dr. Nolte was involved with the installation. He has also purchased some disc golf sets to be given away. They are looking for sponsors for more baskets to be installed later. Signage for the existing baskets is coming soon. Steven Winterton will approach his company about possible sponsorship. Northeastern Counseling is planning a teen night using the Disc Golf baskets. Community feed back has been positive. Roosevelt Branch library has selected Jones and DeMile with Kim Campbell and Associates for the new library construction. CIB will be submitted. The groundbreaking will be March 2022 with a October 2022 completion date. There will be no conflicts with the Cynthia Center for recitals as the Cynthia Center is not really designed for musical performances. A vote on the proposed nature park can not take place today as there is not enough committee members. Considering setting up a food truck round up. The Gusher Trail is mapped out. House of Hope is looking for service projects. Urban Trail would like to meet with the Arts Committee about possible chalk art and murals around town.

Arts: Lynn and Kent Smith said there will be no Interfaith Concerts this summer. The summer theater camp is going on right now. Peter Pan Jr will be performed August 7 at 2 and 6. Feedback is that the camp is better than the Missoula Children's theater. The kids will be wearing masks during the camp and the performances.

Parks: Girls volleyball sign ups are right now. The season starts September 2. Sign up online. On the City website. For girls ages 3rd through 8th grade. The pickle ball courts at the old tennis courts are being painted and are almost finished.

City Council Report: Money was approved for the children's theater camp. Thank you for your time and service.
