

Minutes of the Roosevelt Arts, Parks and Recreation Committee

March 4, 2020

Roosevelt Municipal Building 255 South State Street, Roosevelt Utah

The meeting was called to order at 7 p.m. by Wendy Nicholson, Chairperson

Minutes: A motion from Shannon Staker to approve the February 2020 minutes. 2nd from Emily Graham. The voting was unanimous in favor.

Public Comment:

Roosevelt City Golf Pro Aaron Brown was at the meeting. He offered to help the committee however he could.

Business:

Budget Discussion: \$20,300 in the budget. Each subcommittee gets \$4000. Missoula Children's Theater will come from the general committee budget this year. Mondy Taylor suggested that donations be requested from local businesses. All money from the previous year's budget will roll over.

Social Media: Wendy Nicholson has been handling the social media for the committee. She is using Facebook and Instagram. She asked if anyone else would like to take over the management of the social media accounts or to help out. No one offered. It was suggested that the new Roosevelt city marketing employee could help out once they are hired.

New city web site might be ready in a month.

Logo Proposal: Suggested that we alter the city logo to include: Arts Parks and Recreation. The logo would be used to promote ARP events. Aaron Brown offered to draw something up.

July 4th: Mondy Taylor's band often starts before the main band. She would like to bring more music to downtown with several events. She would like more support from the committee in bringing in music for the July 4th. JR Bird said she could set up some music events for July 4th but would need to coordinate with Mark Winterton. Mondy Taylor plans to set up a summer music festival.

Mark Winterton said via text that the bands for July 4th are planned, sound is planned. The Red Mud Run is planned (with a cost of about \$1200-1600) Mark has the music for the fireworks. He is coordinating with the city for the fireworks. The bands will be Charlie Jenkins and Playlist.

Uintah Basin Music Festival will do some concerts in Constitution part throughout the day at the pavilion near the playground. The music will start at 12. Mondy Taylor suggests having a corn hole tournament after the Red Mud Run to draw more people to the area and the music.

It was suggested that the Arts, Park and Recreation Committee needs to create a master events calendar for the year. This will be done at the April meeting.

Reports from Committees:

Recreation:

The mountain bike trail meeting was successful, however, the private land owners are not all on board so the subcommittee is no longer considering the trail in Ballard. They are looking at new areas for a new trail. The school district has given permission to use some of their land. Some land is available for purchase. Better maps are needed for existing trails.

Bird Festival will be May 9. Advertising has started at the schools. Prizes are being donated. USU will be doing a bird house making activity. There will be food trucks in attendance. North Eastern Aviation Center will be bringing in demos and birds.

Disc Golf plans are moving forward. A map with proposed holes was presented. It would be a 7-hole course at Constitution Park for a total cost of \$2729.65. Each hole costs \$389. The total for signage would be \$3000. An added cement tee pad would be \$200 each. They are looking for community partners. Sponsoring logos could be on the tee signs.

Arts:

Lamb of God: Britney Hawley said the Lamb of God performance would be March 8 at 3:30 and 7 at Union High School She did a radio interview today to promote it. It is a free event. The public can enter the building at 3 pm.

Missoula Children's Theater: Angel Meacham spoke for Britney Fenn who is sick today. It will be July 13-18 at Roosevelt Jr High. The tickets are free. They will ask for donations. Printing cost are \$75-100. \$3500 for Missoula Children's Theater. Housing for the directors is about \$1100. Winterton Suites has offered a discounted rate in the past. Jr High costs \$1100-1300 to rent for the week. The program serves about 60 kids.

Some concerns were raised that the city is spending a lot of money to serve a relatively small amount of the city's children. It was suggested that the Arts Subcommittee might do something locally next year.

Parks:

Co-ed Volleyball starts March 10. There are 12 teams and 2 leagues. The school district is reducing the regular cost of the gym rental.

There will be a Northeastern Utah Educational Center regional art show at the high school April 27-May 1. Reception April 28.

High School Baseball camp will be April 18. MLB Pitch, Hit and Run competition will be at the same time. Pay at the camp.

June 25 will be a Utah Jazz Basketball clinic.

A motion to adjourn by Phillip Bertoch with a 2nd by Steve Winterton. The motion passed unanimously in favor.
