is hereby granted subject to: Utah Depart Transportation's (UDOT's) Regulations For the Accommodation of Utilities on Federal Aid and Non Federal-Aid Highway Right-of-Way, Regulations for the Control and Protection of State Highway Rights of Way, Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, UDOT Specifications for Excavation of State Highway, State Occupational Safety and Health Laws, Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, Instructions to Flaggers, the approved plans, and any special limitations set forth herein, permission for the purpose of **Annual UBIC Parade** within the right of way limits in the following locations: **SR-40 100 East 200 South.**

Highway 0040 Milepost to in/near ROOSEVELT, DUCHESNE county

The permitted work shall commence **8/1/2015** and shall be diligently prosecuted to completion. The work shall be completed and all disturbed surfaces or objects restored on or before **8/1/2015**. In the event work is commenced under this Permit and the permittee fails or refuses to complete the work, UDOT may, at its election, correct any deficiencies or otherwise complete the permitted work at the expense of the permittee. Upon receipt of an invoice of the costs incurred by UDOT, permittee shall immediately pay the amount due. If an action is required to be filed in court to collect the amount due, permittee shall be liable for UDOT's costs and fees, including attorney's fees.

Before work permitted is commenced, the permittee shall notify the Inspector listed below. ie: **(**** 24 Hours before....****)**. By applying for the Permit and UDOT issuing the Permit, permittee will comply with all instructions, conditions, requirements, and regulations of UDOT with respect to performance of the work described in the Permit. Permittee will properly control and warn the public of said work within UDOT's rights-of-way to prevent any accidents. Permittee shall defend, indemnify, and hold harmless UDOT from all damages or claims, including attorneys fees, arising out of any and all actions performed under this Permit by permittee, permittee's employees, agents or contractors, including failure to comply with terms and conditions in this Permit. Permittee shall pay for UDOT's inspections fees.

Permittee shall hold an insurance policy in the amount of \$5,000,000.00, as determined by the Regional Director/District Engineer.

Permittee shall not perform any work on state highway rights-of-way beyond those areas of operation described on this Permit.

If permittee fails to comply with UDOT's regulations, specifications, or instructions pertinent to this Permit, the Region Director/District Engineer or his duly authorized representative, may by verbal order, suspend the work until the violation is corrected. If permittee fails or refuses to promptly comply, the Region Director/District Engineer or his authorized representative may issue a written order stopping all or any part of the work. When satisfactory corrective action is taken, an order permitting resumption of work may be issued.

Special Limitations:

- Any asphalt damaged by your work will require a mill and overlay of the entire effected area with UDOT approved HMA mix design asphalt, from an approved source.
- Licensee must do all work in accordance with UDOT standard drawings.
- Use current edition of UDOT standard drawing for traffic control. Use MUTCD stardards for traffic control elements not shown in UDOT standard drawings. Traffic control must be posted at the encroachment site for entire encroachment period.
- Traffic Control Plans, signs and channelizing devices must conform to MUTCD Standards, as a minimum, and all signs must be equipped with three orange flags.
- This agreement and/or permit is UDOT approval only. You are responsible to obtain clearances from railroads, private property owners and local jurisdictions that you are working within.
- ATSSA Certified Traffic Control Maintainer required.
- Licensee must do all work in accordance with UDOT approved plans.
- All work must comply with current ADA standards.
- All road closures must be manned by Uniformed Police Officers during the entire closure period.
- Applicant certifies that all participants have signed a Waiver and Release of Damages against the State of Utah for participation in an approved special event on State Roads.
- Licensee will be responsible to clean up the highway after the event.
- Notice to the public of any road closure must be given in advance of the event, as determined by Regional Permit Officer, by advertising through radio or newspaper.
- In Utah, a bicycle is considered a vehicle and must abide by the same rules of the road.
- Spectators must be kept a safe distance from the participants to view this event.
- No pavement markings or removal of signs are allowed.

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- Any motorized vehicle in the parade must be operated in a safe manner by a licensed driver. The practice of throwing candy to the parade spectators is prohibited.
- No advertising is permitted on UDOT right of way for your event.
- Permit Holder will comply with all applicable environmental laws.
- A copy of the permit must be present at the encroachment site for the entire encroachment period.

By carrying out the activities allowed by this permit it is conclusive evidence that I have accepted all provisions, limitations, and restrictions of the permit and attachments, understand and agree to all penalties for failing to comply with them, and understand my ability to review a permit and applicable attachments at the appropriate region/district office.
