WATER PETITION
Of
ROOSEVELT CITY
To
DUCHESNE COUNTY WATER CONSERVANCY DISTRICT

WHEREAS, ROOSEVELT CITY, a political subdivision of the State of Utah (“Petitioner”) has entered negotiations with the DUCHESNE COUNTY WATER CONSERVANCY DISTRICT (“District”) for the District to provide the Petitioner water through a water pipeline known as the Victory Pipeline to be extended from Starvation Reservoir to the Roosevelt area.

WHEREAS, the Petitioner has authorized its Chief Executive Officer to submit a written Petition to the Duchesne County Water Conservancy District on behalf of the Petitioner to enter into a water contract under Title 17B, Chapter 2a, Section 1007 of the Utah Code; and

WHEREAS, Section 1007 of Title 17B Chapter 2a, Utah Code provides conservancy districts certain rights as contract assessments if certain notices and public hearings are held; and

WHEREAS, Petitioner files this Petition to purchase water from the Duchesne County Water Conservancy District; and

NOW THEREFORE, as authorized by the governing body of the Petitioner, it makes the following water petition to the Duchesne County Water Conservancy District as follows:

1. The Governing Body of the Petitioner on February 25, 2016, authorized entering into a Water Supply Contract with the District in the amount of 1000 acre feet of water annually from the Victory Pipeline.
2. The water will benefit the land within the Petitioner’s boundaries and this petition is for properties within those boundaries.
3. The cost of water will be the Duchesne County Water Conservancy District’s actual cost of treated water (currently estimated at \$190 per acre foot), plus the cost of the raw water (currently estimated at \$50 per acre foot), plus \$0.55 per thousand gallons for the initial 5 years, with the right of the Duchesne County Water Conservancy District to adjust the cost of water per thousand gallons every 5 years or when the Duchesne County Water Conservancy District incurs additional debt with respect to the Victory Pipeline. Payments will be made in cash equivalents monthly from the Petitioner’s water revenues.

4. The Petitioner requests the following turnouts and connection(s)_____.
18 inch connection with an 18 inch meter at 40° 18' 69" North, 110° 04' 12" West at approximately 5000 West and 500 feet north of South Cove Road.
5. In making this petition, Petitioner requests that the contract assessment authorized by Section 17B-2a-1007, Utah Code Annotated become a lien on the land within the Petitioner's boundaries which are described on Exhibit "A" attached hereto.
6. Petitioner agrees to be bound by Section 1007 of Title 17B, Chapter 2a of the Utah Code imposing an assessment lien on the lands in its service area and the other rules and regulations of the Duchesne County Water Conservancy District.
7. Petitioner requests the District to hold a public hearing regarding this petition and, subject to the comments at the public hearing, grant this petition.
